ANZAC DAY AND THE SPIRIT OF ANZAC
Yesterday we were lucky to have a special visitor from the Royal Australian Army Core of Transport to talk and present to our Middle and Senior School students about the spirit and meaning of ANZAC. Sgt Rhys Fountain captivated students sharing many interesting and informative facts and perspectives about the history of how the spirit of ANZAC came about from WW1 and then was entrenched over the next 100 years. He shared how young Australian men and women represented our country in different situations around the world, both conflict and aid support to help make a safer and more democratic world. He shared some stories about his army equipment and even training experiences and reasons for why he chose to join the army.



Students got to ask lots of questions and explore their further wonderings with Sqt Rhys and were encouraged and reminded why it is important that we remember the soldiers, nurses and other service people that have paved the way for us to enjoy our lifestyle and democratic freedoms that we are so privileged to enjoy here in Australia. Sqt Rhys encouraged students to implement the values and characteristics shown by our service people throughout the years in their own life and here at school when they work as a team in class and in the yard playing.

Please ask your children to elaborate upon their experience and share with you their insights and understandings for why ANZAC Day is an important day in our culture.
